



WOODROW WILSON STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Q: How do students apply to the program?

A: Students apply online at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/CS3TD8Y>.

Q: What are the requirements to apply?

A: Applicants must be entering the 10th, 11th or 12th grade, complete registration online, and provide two letters of recommendation from teachers. The reference letter can be completed at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/SYBP3V9>.

Q: When is the deadline to apply?

A: All applications must be complete by October 16, 2017.

Q: Who can apply?

A: Any 10th, 11th or 12th grade student can apply. We accept applications from students in public and private schools as well as students who are home educated.

Q: Can out of state students apply?

A: Yes but transportation is not provided and is the responsibility of the student or parent. Transportation will be provided to Washington from the library.

Q: Do students need to bring their own lunch or snacks?

A: Lunch and snacks will be provided but if a student has food allergies, they should bring their own meal.

Q: Is there a dress code?

A: Yes. Students are required to wear business casual. That would be conservative clothing. Not allowed: shorts, short skirts, jeans, and tennis shoes, shirts with logos, or tank tops, or hoodies.

Q: What if a student has a conflict with one of the events?

A: Students accepted into the program are expected to participate in all four events. Students who miss one of the first three events will not be invited on the Washington trip.

Q: Are parents allowed to stay during the events?

A: Parents are not allowed to participate in the event, however they may wish to purchase an admission ticket and tour the museum. Museum hours are from 9 AM – 5 PM
